such as honeydew, pineapple, orange blossom.
This wine has a nose like no other.

Apple Cranberry \$6

sweet NH apples & tart Massachusetts
cranberries unite in this crisp fruit wine

Flag Hill White \$6

delicate white wine with hints of citrus & pear
complimented by a hint of oak & a clean finish
Suggested for those who enjoy Pinot Grigio

Marechal Foch \$6

a soft, medium bodied red wine
aged in French and American oak barrels.
Foch wine is characterized by lingering flavors of
cherry & plum with nice acidity.
